MISS M HAMLYN PERPETUAL SILVER SALVER – Exhibitor with most points in Classes 1-3

DARTMOOR PONY SOCIETY ROSETTE – Best Dartmoor Pony, shown by an Exhibitor who is a member of the Dartmoor Pony Society and produces their Membership Card in the ring.

SPECIAL ROSETTE for the Best Dartmoor Foal in Class 2 sired by a Registered Dartmoor Stallion

*Definition of a Dartmoor Hill Pony: A pony bred on the Commons of Dartmoor by a registered Commoner, and whose sire and dam run/ran on the said Commons. This ensures that the sire has been approved and branded by the Dartmoor Commoners as a suitable stallion to run on the Commons.*

## Conditions of Entry

1. Entries in the Pony, Horse and Sheep Classes to be made to the Hon Agricultural Secretary: Sally Hicks Beach, Rogues Roost, Poundsgate, Newton Abbot, Devon TQ13 7PS. (Telephone 01647 221233) to be received no later than **WEDNESDAY, 24<sup>th</sup> AUGUST 2011.**

**Please note:**

**No late entries will be accepted for the Horse, Pony, Sheep or Cattle Classes.**

2. Entrance Fees must accompany entries, **together with a stamped addressed envelope.**
  3. All horses, ponies, cattle and sheep to be on the ground by 8.30 am. Judging will commence at 9.00am prompt.
  4. Any competitor who causes delay will be disqualified. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event or class.
  5. The Widcombe Fair Committee Co Ltd reserves the right to judge classes in the order they think fit.
  6. Only one prize in each class will be awarded if there are only two entrants and only two prizes will be awarded if there are only three entrants.
  7. All exhibits to remain on view until after the Parade of Prize Winners. Winners of the horse and pony classes are requested to take part in the Grand Parade.
  8. All horses, ponies, cattle and sheep to be bona-fide property of the exhibitor on the closing date of entry.
  9. All persons mounted on horses or ponies, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat to the relevant British Safety Standard.
  10. 'LOCAL' shall be deemed to mean that the owner lives in the parishes served by "The Parish Link" or Buckland-in-the-Moor at the closing date of entry. For Local Riding Classes, children attending Widcombe School will be eligible.
  11. All age restrictions to be counted up to and including Fair Day.
  12. Cups will be presented on Fair Day and Winners are required to sign a receipt and have their name and date engraved on the Trophy at their own expense.
  13. It is the Owners' obligation to keep animals watered.
  14. Competitors and Exhibitors in the livestock classes must hold their own Public Liability Insurance.
