### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1.The Judges decision will be final in all cases.
- 2.Exhibitors may show all vegetables as they wish, trimmed or untrimmed unless stated in the schedule.
- 3.Only one entry per exhibitor in each class.
- 4.Entries to be staged by 9.00 a.m.
- 5.The marquee will be cleared at 9.30 a.m. of all competitors. Only officials to remain until judges have Finished..
- 6.Exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor and either grown by them or in their possession for three months (Cakes, bread, flower arrangements and handicrafts must have been produced by the exhibitor).
- 7.Constitution of the Exhibit-It must be as per schedule, neither more or less than the number or quantity.
- 8.Any exhibit not as schedule will be disqualified.
- 9.After judging, no entry to be altered or moved until the end of the show.
- 10.Exhibits may be removed between 4.30 and 5.00 p.m..
- 11.The show committee wish to make it clearly understood that they will not be responsible for any accident occurring to spectators or for the damage or loss of property.
- 12.The judges have the power to withhold any prize if the exhibits are not in their opinion of sufficient merit.
- 13.The Committee reserve the right to visit exhibitors plot or gardens.
- 14.Points to be 3=1<sup>st</sup>, 2=2<sup>nd</sup>, 1=3<sup>rd</sup>. To be calculated for the trophies.

Highest points in classes 1 to 16 for the silver salver.
